1 Rules

This is a handicap race. The race will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, WKSC Sailing Regulations and these instructions.

2 Entries

- a) The event is open to all WKSC and DSC members who can provide the Official Handicapper with a recognised PN handicap number for their boat. (Cruisers, Tidal Classes, Fast and Slow Handicap Dinghies and Multihulls).
- b) PNs will be identified by class listed on the WKSC PN List 2020 (available on club notice board)
- c) The number of crew on a boat may be different from that required by their Class Association. However, as always, sailing is at the competitors' risk and each person should carefully assess their capabilities and the capabilities of their crew in the conditions prevailing before launching, as stated in WKSC Sailing Regulation 1.

3 Safety

This is a long distance race and competitors are reminded of their responsibilities under WKSC Regulation 1 and personal buoyancy Regulation 4. If the Race Officer has concerns for safety a competitor may be instructed to return to the shore and will be deemed to have retired.

4 Sign-On and Sign-Off Sheet

In order to assist the race team please email anthonymarston@sky.com with your sail number, boat class and your name if you intend to compete, by **19.00 on Saturday 1**st **August**. By doing so you are accepting these sailing instructions. Entries made after this time will still be accepted.

5 Notices to Competitors. Will be posted on the club notice board in front of the club house.

6 Race area. The Dee Estuary.

7 Changes to Sailing Instructions.

Any changes to the sailing instructions will be indicated by flying flag "L" before the warning signal of the race. The flag may be flown from the WKSC clubhouse or the Race Committee Boat, as appropriate. The changes may be posted in the club house or verbally on the water.

8 Starting and Code Flag

There will be a single handicap class start at 09.45. RRS 26 (5,4,1,0) will apply. The class flag will be code flag 'W'.

9 Course for the Mostyn Race.

10 Time Limit.

Will be 150 minutes.



COURSE CARD

- 1 The Committee Boat will be "Little Arvor" flying the WKSC burgee.
- 2 The Start Line will be between "Little Arvor" (S) and Start Mark (P).
- 3 The course will be:

Start Line to Mark 1 (P) then to Finish line between "Little Arvor" (P) and Finish Mark (S).



Marks:	Mark 1 will be an orange pillar buoy
	Start and Finish Mark will be a spherical mark with a flag on top
