Race 6

These instructions should be read in conjunction with the Sailing Instructions.

1. Class Code Flags and Start Times

There will be 2 races sailed back to back for Race 6.

There will be no discards.

Average lap times will be used.

2. Marks

Marks 1, 2,3 and 4 will be inflatable orange pillar buoys with dark horizontal bands.

Mark 2 will be flying a blue flag.

The Start Mark (SM) will be a red dan buoy.

3. The Course

The course is shown on the next page.

4. The Start

4.1 Boats will start between the Committee Boat (CB) Little Arvor, flying an orange flag and the Start Mark.

4.2 Races will be started in accordance with RRS Rule 26. (5,4,1,0)

5. Race Duration

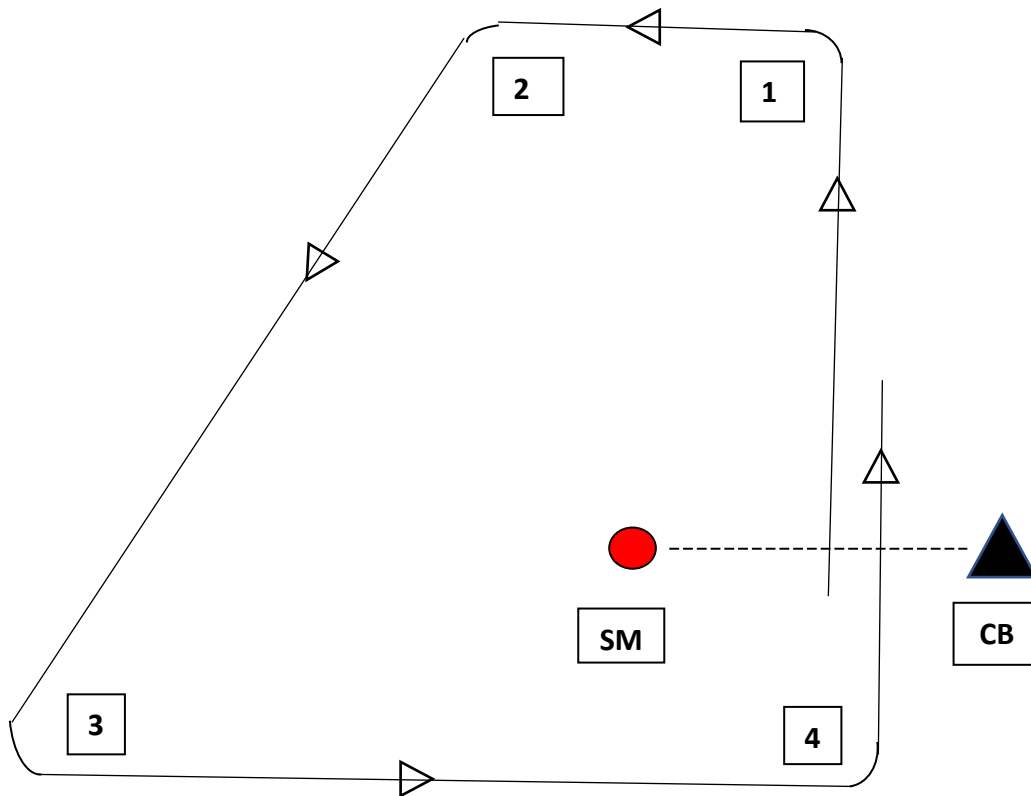
There will be no fixed number of laps, and boats should continue to sail the course as described until signalled otherwise.

6. Finish

The race will normally be signalled as shortened after competitors have rounded Mark 4 by flying code flag "S" from the Committee Boat. Boats will finish between the Committee Boat and SM or the Race Officer may, at his entire discretion, decide to finish the race at a rounding mark. In that case the finish will be between a RIB flying a blue flag and an S flag and the nearby rounding mark, finishing in the direction from the last mark.

The Course:

The diagram is indicative only, marks are not numbered.



The Course for Race 6:

Start Line: Between the Committee Boat flying an orange flag (Starboard) and the Starting Mark (SM) (Port)

All laps will be:

- Mark 1 (Port)
- Mark 2 (Port)
- Mark 3 (Port)
- Mark 4 (Port)

Through the line between Committee Boat (Starboard) and SM (Port) in the direction of Mark 1.

Competitors should note that after the start the Starting Mark may be moved closer to the Committee Boat entirely at the discretion of the Race Officer. No flags will be flown or sound signals made to indicate this.

Racing will continue until shortened.
