## Races 1 - 4

These instructions should be read in conjunction with the Sailing Instructions.

### 1. Class Code Flags and Start Times

There will be 2 races sailed back to back for each Class. Note that the second races may not be started in the order shown above. There will be no discards.

### 2. Marks

Marks 1, 2, 3 and 4 will be inflatable orange pillar marks. Mark 1A will be an inflatable orange pillar mark with a flag on top.

The Start Mark (SM) will be an orange spherical buoy.

The Inner Mark (IM) will be an orange pillar buoy with a blue jacket which will also be the Finish Mark.

### 3. The Course

The course is shown on the next page.

### 4. The Start

4.1 Boats will start between the Committee Boat (CB) WKSC T'Ark, flying a DSC or WKSC burgee and the Start Mark (SM).

**4.2 On all subsequent laps boats will pass between CB and Inner Mark (IM) when sailing from Mark 4 to Mark 1 (or Mark 1A).**

4.3 Races will be started in accordance with rule 26. (5,4,1,0)

### 5. Race Duration

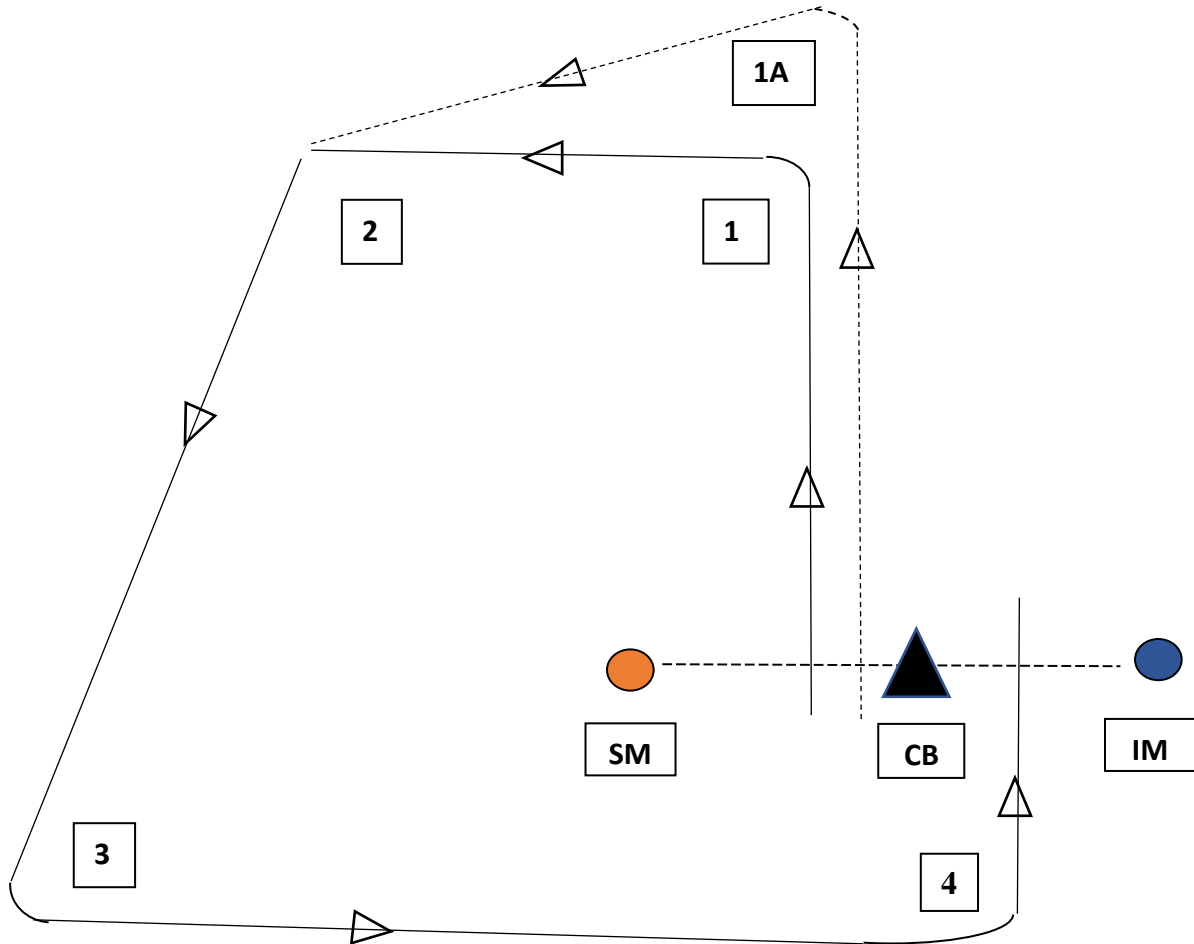
There will be no fixed number of laps, and boats should continue to sail the course as described until signalled otherwise.

### 6. Finish

The race will normally be signalled as shortened after competitors have rounded Mark 4 by flying code flag "S" from the Committee Boat. **Boats will finish between the Committee Boat and Inner Mark** or the Race Officer may, at his entire discretion, decide to finish the race at a rounding mark. In that case the finish will be between a RIB flying a blue flag and an S flag and the nearby rounding mark, finishing in the direction from the last mark.

The diagram is indicative only, marks are not numbered.



## **Races 1-3**

Start Line: Start Mark (Port) & Committee Boat (Starboard)

Each lap:

Mark 1 (Port)

Mark 2 (Port)

Mark 3 (Port)

Mark 4 (Port)

Through the line between Committee Boat (Port) and Inner Mark (Starboard) in the direction of Mark 1

## **Race 4**

Start Line: Start Mark (Port) & Committee Boat (Starboard)

Each lap:

Mark 1A (Port)

Mark 2 (Port)

Mark 3 (Port)

Mark 4 (Port)

Through the line between Committee Boat (Port) and Inner Mark (Starboard) in the direction of Mark 1A

All classes will continue until shortened.
