<b>Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> August:</b> There will be a Pursuit Race

<b>Courses</b>
<b>Saturday/Sunday 21<sup>st</sup>/22<sup>nd</sup> August: Class Racing</b> - All classes will start from one Committee Boat and will race round Estuary cans. All classes will have two races sailed back-to-back.
<b>Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> August: Handicap Racing</b> - All boats will start together from one Committee Boat, race round a laid course and use Average Lap Times. There will be two races sailed back-to-back.
<b>Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> August:</b> There will be one Handicap Race. All boats will start together (one start) from the Committee Boat. Racing will be round the estuary marks and Average Lap Times will be used. The race will start at 12.00.
