All boats must have a valid class certificate and valid third party insurance for a minimum of £3,000,000 covering all competitors who sail her. All boats must have adequate buoyancy and personal buoyancy must be of an approved design and worn at all times when afloat.

The safety of a boat and her entire management shall be the sole responsibility of the competitor(s) racing the boat, who must ensure that the boat and themselves are adequate to face the conditions that may arise during the course of the race.

Neither the sailing instructions nor the inspection of the boat under these conditions in any way limits or reduces the absolute responsibility of the competitor(s) for themselves, the boat and the management thereof. The race organisers shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, howsoever caused, to the competitor(s) as a result of their taking part in the race or races. Moreover every competitor is absolutely responsible for the suitability of the boat for the race or races.

Declaration:

- I agree to be bound by the Racing Rules of Sailing and all other rules that govern this event. In particular I confirm that I have read the Notice of Race and Conditions of Entry and accept their provisions and agree that my boat will conform to them throughout the event.
